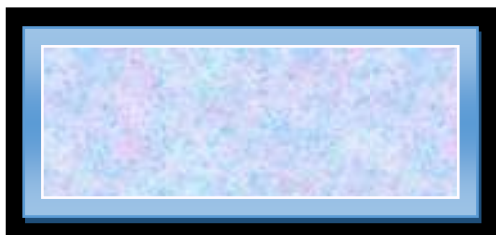
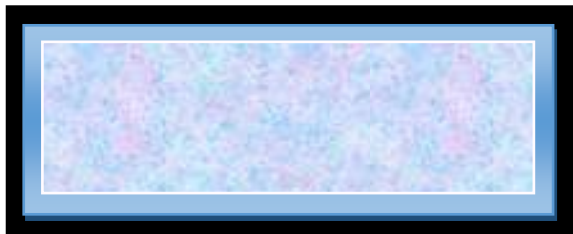

Card base: 21cm x 15cm, score @ 10.5cm & 2.25cm, fold in half & back on itself.

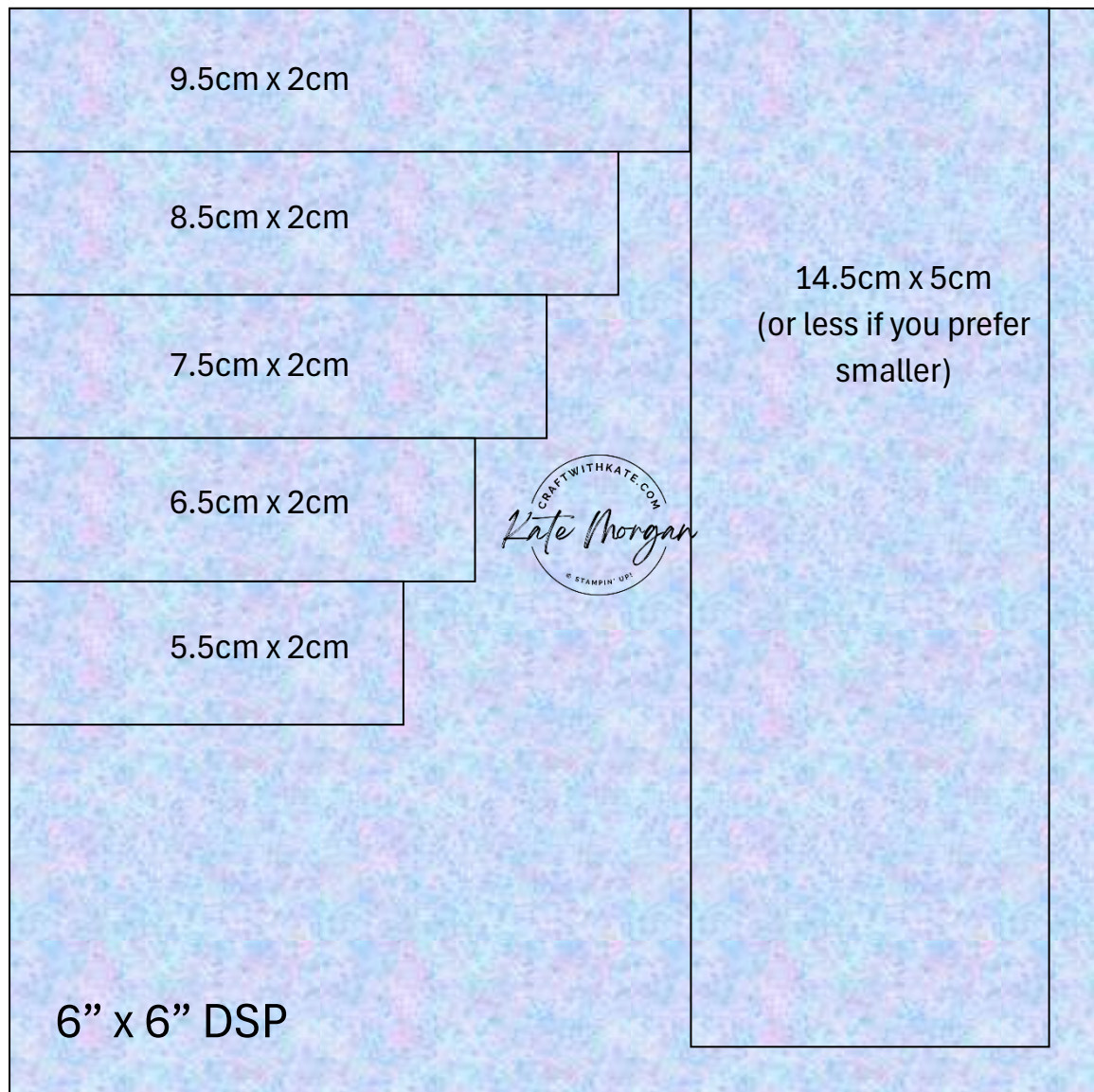
Cut all the Panels, Matts & DSP layers and glue together.

Panel	Base (black)	Matt (blue)	DSP (pattern)
Panel #1	10.5cm x 3cm	10cm x 2.5cm	9.5cm x 2cm
Panel #2	9.5cm x 3cm	9cm x 2.5cm	8.5cm x 2cm
Panel #3	8.5cm x 3cm	8cm x 2.5cm	7.5cm x 2cm
Panel #4	7.5cm x 3cm	7cm x 2.5cm	6.5cm x 2cm
Panel #5	6.5cm x 3cm	6cm x 2.5cm	5.5cm x 2cm



Cutting the DSP

Depends on the pattern of the DSP, but something like this below. The long panel is adhered to the inside right panel, so the pattern flows across the card when it is open. Start by cutting the 9.5cm across the top of the DSP, then into strips of 2cm and trim excess.



Inside

Left Panel – Matt 5cm x 14.5cm and Basic White card 4.5cm x 14cm

Right Panel – Matt 10cm x 14.5cm (dry embossed) with DSP 14cm x 5cm
